Artful Adventure to the MFA

Guided Tour of the Museum of Fine Arts
May 8, 2019 12:15pm - 4:30pm

Dover PTO's annual **Artful Adventure at the Museum of Fine Arts** will be held this year



on the afternoon of early release Wednesday, May 8, 2019. Last year we sold-out with 100 students joining the Artful Adventure, which includes a guided tour of the MFA and an individual art project. The tours are very well curated and differ every year, so returning students are exposed to different artwork each visit. The individual art projects are also different every year and based on the theme of the year's tour. Everyone has a really good time and learns a lot! Please note that space is strictly limited (the trip sold out 6 of the past 7 years), so don't wait until the last minute to sign-up. The trip is open to children in grades 1-5.



PARENTS: Please consider joining us as a chaperone this year. We literally couldn't make this trip work without parent chaperones. It is important that chaperones are available to join us not just at the MFA, but at Chickering before the kids are released from school so that they can assist with getting the kids into groups, fed lunch, and onto the buses. We have a limited number of spaces available for chaperones, so act fast if you want to join us. Also, please be aware that we cannot guarantee that all chaperones will be assigned to their children's group during the actual guided tour of the museum, as each group needs several chaperones, but there will be many opportunities to interact with your child during the trip.

REGISTRATION: Please register your child at <https://goo.gl/emx9gn> and send in your payment school by April 26th in an envelope labeled "**MFA Trip c/o Peter Hoffmann**". This trip is offered on a first-come, first-served basis, so don't wait until the last minute. Checks should be made payable to Dover PTO. The total cost for each student is \$20, which includes admission to MFA, guided tour and art activity, snack, and round trip bus transportation. There is a \$10 cost for chaperones. If the trip is sold out, we will let you know and return your payment to you.

STUDENTS must bring a packed lunch from home to eat in the Chickering cafeteria before the bus ride. Our tour of the MFA is planned from 1.30 – 3 pm. The bus will leave from Chickering at 12:30 and will be back around 4:15pm. We will provide a snack before we board the buses back to Chickering.
